What Are LDW Systems and How Do They Work?

I love the idea but I was curious how they really work. So here is the answer. There are two primary types of lane departure warning technologies. The first type is typically referred to as a Lane Departure Warning (LDW) system. These systems monitor the lane markings on the roadway, which allows them to sound an alarm whenever a vehicle starts to deviate from its lane. The driver can then take corrective action, which can prevent a run-off-road accident or a collision with another vehicle.

The other type of lane departure warning system is more proactive, so it is often referred to as a Lane-Keeping System (LKS), Lane-Keeping Assist, or another similar name. These systems also monitor lane markings, but they are capable of taking corrective action. If the driver doesn't respond to an initial warning, a Lane-Keeping System can typically take action to keep the vehicle from drifting.


