While the weather may not indicate it, we are supposed to be in spring. That means that we are actually getting close to the Grand National. If you have not yet registered, remember that the registration fee goes up after May 20th. That's right around the corner. I also want to remind everyone that there is a separate registration form for your car(s). Registration for you and your family does not automatically register your car. You must fill out the separate form wherein you provide the vehicle details and choose the judging class or display category. The deadlines for the vehicle registration are the same as for the event registration previously mentioned.

I am planning to bring four of my Cadillacs to the show. That means a lot of preparation work. However, this cool spring weather has made it difficult to want to work on the cars. When it's warm, it is nice to throw open the garage door, turn the radio on, and get to work. When it's cold like this, I don't have the same motivation. Unfortunately, that means I'm going to be working right up to the very end. I'm sure that I am not the only one as I know a few others of you that still have work you are planning to complete. If nothing else, this GN will be the motivation we need to get our projects finished.

Another event that I want to highlight is the car show at Naperville North High School. This car show provides two purposes. First, it is a fundraiser for the auto shop to help pay for new tools. West of the Lake Region Members toured Joliet Iron Works Historic Site



Joliet was once home to the second largest steel mill in the entire U.S. The plant opened in 1869 and ceased operations in the 1980's. There were four blast furnaces capable of producing 2,000 tons of pig iron daily. It was a laborious and dangerous process. Today, the blast furnaces are gone and the site is reminiscent of the Roman ruins. For history buffs like many of us are, this is a fascinating part of local history that few know anything about.

The 1.5 hour tour was led by Amy of the Forest Preserve District of Will County which owns the site today. Amy provided detailed explanations of the history, operations, and remains to create images of an interesting, but grueling process that left this area decades ago. While the site is always open to the public, tour guides are only available to group tours, so this was our lucky day.

It's quite possible that you may be the only one-on-one impression visitors have of our region, and we'd like everyone to have a positive experience. Besides, you may make a new friend or two. An Important message to readers of the US Mail version of this newsletter

You are all important and valued members of our club and we are grateful to have each of you as members. I understand that there are some members of our club that cannot receive the newsletter by e-mail, the reasons are varied: One member has a disability and can't operate electronic devices, another member that I consider a very good personal friend is "off-the-grid" and won't use any electronic equipment (sounding wiser and wiser each day). Both models also feature advanced, extensively track- and road-tested high-performance braking systems. The CT5-V Blackwing features the largest factory-installed brakes in Cadillac history, along with an available lightweight carbon-ceramic brake package that offers weight savings, durability and heat management.




