1986 Cadillac Fleetwood D'Elegance

A 1986 Cadillac Fleetwood Brougham D'Elegance sold new at Sewell Village Cadillac in Dallas on February 18, 1986 to J.D. Fruge of Garland, TX for \$25,845.05. He was a ham radio operator and his wife drove the car until her passing in 2002. It then sat in a barn at the family heir of the Fruge estate in De Kalb, Texas for close to 18 years, and has slightly over 29,000 miles on it. However, as a result of sitting for 18 years, the car has what is referred to as high-class problems.

The car was sold at Mecum auction to me on September 9, 2021 in Dallas Texas from the estate. It was on a Thursday afternoon and nobody was really paying attention as it rolled up on the red carpet which is when I decided to pounce. The upholstery is in pristine condition and there have never been any accidents. I still have the original sales receipt from February 1986 and the original window sticker. I also have the original booklet and sales invoice which is virtually unheard of.

The vehicle is a rear wheel drive and has the 5L Oldsmobile 307 engine with a four barrel carburetor. It is also the first year that Cadillac put a third rear brake light in the rear window. The car has also required the entire fuel system to be replaced including the entire fuel tank due to the sediment buildup from sitting for 18 years. I have included a picture of the fuel filter and a picture of the fuel filter cut open showing the clogging. It is now with a master mechanic and is presently being mechanically restored and expected to be roadworthy in early 2022.



THE BIRTH OF A PONTIAC SALESMAN



MARY KAY'S PINK LONE STAR CADILLACS—I WAS THERE!

This spectacular historical scene at Mary Kay Cosmetics world headquarters, Dallas, Texas, features over 50 "new" 1984 specially painted Cadillac Coupe Deville. They were styled with elegant white leather and white cabriolet tops. Lone Star Cadillac of Dallas VIP ordered, carefully prepared, delivered and presented these Mary Kay mountain laurel pink Cadillacs. Prior to this only the top National Sales Directors received the pink Cadillacs. This shows the proud Mary Kay Directors receiving their Cadillacs after their units qualified for the car. Their top performance will continue to earn the pink Cadillac.

After my previous Lone Star article, a good friend wrote this to me, *I am still eager to read the story about Cadillac and Mary Kay Ash. How did Cadillac win that client, who chose the color, and what happens to all the old pink Cadillacs*. Mary Kay carefully observed that wherever people of prominence gather, Cadillac is the pre-eminent car on the scene. No motor car in the world today attends as many gala and impressive functions. The owner driven Cadillac motor car provides luxury, distinction and stature complimenting your wisdom and good taste.

Mary Kay is remembered for this first year mountain laurel pink 1956 Cadillac Eldorado Seville Coupe with factory chrome saber spoke wheels, correct white walls and white top. This very unique image of poise, elegance and class is synonymous with gorgeous women! This era in pink created the 1955-1957 T-birds, 1957 Lincoln and 1957 Mercury Turnpike Cruiser.



Cadillac, at great expense, in order to accommodate the production of Mary Kay Cadillacs, required the redyeing of all plastic rear quarter panel and front fender fillers to match the pink paint. Otherwise they would be silver and absolutely butt ugly. Cadillac also noted that the reason for the short three year run of pink Cadillacs in the late 50'S was because the public rejected that color of the era. Now Cadillac insisted that all Mary Kay Cadillacs at the time would come with factory white leather and a white quarter top and correct white wall tires. It is stated by some that the pink color is dreadful. The white leather, white top and white walls made the same color appear to be soft, pastel, and elegant. White leather was abolished in 1996. The pink Cadillacs continue to arrive with dark grey cloth interior or grey leather.

Lone Star Cadillac was the overwhelming choice as the delivering dealer. Seen in all the right places since 1934, Lone Star Cadillac owned five city blocks of downtown Dallas. We had

massive storage capabilities, a huge support staff, and resources. We even had our own fuel storage facilities on the premises. The other four stand alone Cadillac competitors were hopelessly hemmed in geographically and lack of facilities. Now comes the rub. You must understand that Lone Star Cadillac had 13 sales people that placed the dealership in the top 10 of the United States. I was salesman of the year four times. In order to be fair, anyone who came in the showroom even asking for directions was considered an up. Your chance to wait on a potential customer. One person was designated to hold welcome classes for the new Mary Kay Cadillac owners. No one ever showed up. We at Lone Star Cadillac extended every courtesy to our owners who represent the leadership of Texas. We must be selective as to who gets free pick up and delivery, limousine service, complementary servicing and car washes including topping off their fuel tanks all at no charge. The Mary Kay folks were screaming that they too wanted the same consideration of people who purchased or leased here. In many cases if considerations weren't altered, they were on the phone to Mary Kay personally. We also had to field some heart breaking pink Cadillac directors who had not met quotas and had to turn their Cadillac into the dealership. The situation became so untenable, that Lone Star Cadillac after one year was delighted to hand over the Mary Kay Cadillacs to Roger Meir Cadillac at LBJ and Marsh. There are many excellent Mary Kay representatives who purchased Cadillacs on their own from us and became life time customers and friends.

Cadillac Motor Car Division at great expense has been painting with lacquer since the mid

1920's. It is extremely durable and has brilliant reflection qualities. Five to ten year old Cadillacs properly cared for with frequent beauty treatments will protect that lacquer glass look. Unfortunately, pink that is neglected and exposed to excessive salt spray, precipitation, sunlight, bruising car washes, bird droppings, and atmospheric containments left untreated will scar and bruise the finish right through the four coats of paint and two coats of primer. Nothing is more homily than a badly neglected pink Cadillac where ever it may be. Nobody wants it, not even for free. Don't forget, around 1989 I think, Mary Kay went to the Sedan Deville. Without a white top or white leather, it was offensive looking. So the real glory days in my view of the Mary Kay pink Cadillacs are Coupe DeVilles with white leather, white top and correct white walls. Even pink lacquer can be wet sanded, buffed, touched up and look great. White leather can be redyed so reconditioning enhanced its new looking image. The pink Sedan DeVilles with grey interior were so dreadful in appearance that they never even got a bid at national auctions with-



This 1957 Coupe Deville in factory mountain laurel pink with white top made the pink appear to be much softer. It had a gorgeous pink leather and black brocade interior and excellent chrome functional bumper exhausts. I installed a used set of highly desirable Cadillac chrome saber spoke wheels with correct white walls. The driver's door power window was inoperative and the motor was shot. This is 1976-1977 and we didn't have rock auto or other sources for reproduction trim and power components. I covered the onen window in plastic but then knew I was moving for

out a complete repaint in white. White is forgiving as it does not show bumps, lumps and dents.


It was so great to see lots of familiar faces and enjoyed visitation



The London to Brighton Veteran Car Run is the world's longest-running motoring event, held on a course between London and Brighton, England. To qualify, participating cars must have been built before 1905. The run has taken place most years since its initial revival in 1927. It currently takes place on the first Sunday in November, starting at sunrise in Hyde Park, London, and mostly following the old A23 road to the finish at Brighton – a distance of 54 miles (87 km). These were some of the Cadillacs, still running, that were part of the run this year.
